The territory which falls within the competence of the tourist office Rahin & Chérimont counts about 12.000 inhabitants and includes 9 towns. Those towns are Belverme, Clairegoutte, Champagney, Echavanne, Frédéric-Fontaine, Frahier-et-Chatebier, Plancher-Bas, Plancher-les-Mines and Ronchamp. Located along the RN19 national road which connects Paris to Switzerland, the Rahin & Chérimont towns community territory will let you discover the first hills of the Vosges mountains as well as beautiful green and preserved landscapes.

The well-known Notre-Dame-du-Haut chapel, built in Ronchamp by Le Corbusier in the mid-fifties, is visible from far away. Ronchamp is also housing an interesting mining museum and Champagney, which is close, a surprising House of Negritude and Human Rights linked to the willpower of its population to abolish slavery from 1789.

Numerous hiking trails are starting from Ronchamp and Plancher-les-Mines.
